

Inq-ITS and Google

Inq-ITS is now able to connect directly to your Google account. This will allow you to sign-in to Inq-ITS using your school Google account, and then assign and post links from Inq-ITS to Google Classroom. If you already have a teacher account with Inq-ITS, simply follow the directions below to connect to your Google account.

Linking to Google

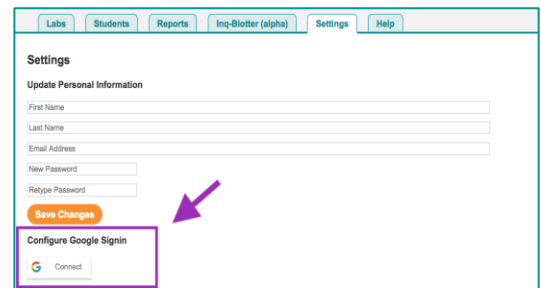
To start, go to INQITS.COM through an up-to-date version of Google Chrome, Firefox, or Safari. On the homepage, sign-in to your teacher portal using your **existing Inq-ITS account**. If you cannot remember your password, click **Don't know your password?** and you will be able to reset it.



Once you are signed-in to the teacher portal, click on the **settings** tab.

Next click the Google **Connect** button to configure your Google sign-in and link to Google. Be sure to sign-in using the Google email that is connected to your school account.

Once your accounts are connected, you will be able to assign labs directly to Google Classroom and sign-in to Inq-ITS using your Google account.



Assigning Labs to Google Classroom

After you have connected Google to your Inq-ITS account, you will be able to assign and post labs directly into Google Classroom.



On the **Lab** screen, click **Assign a Lab**. Once you **Assign** a lab, the lab will appear under your **Assigned Labs** list and you will see the option to **Post to Google Classroom**.

Click **Post to Google Classroom** and choose the class that you would like to assign the lab to. You will see a notification that the lab has successfully posted to Google Classroom. An active link will now be available in your Google Classroom stream, and the lab is ready to be used.
